**Dogs on short leads. Dogs not to be off the lead at any time. There are sheep on the farm. Gates to be kept shut at all times.**

All classes will be run under Pony Club Mounted Games rules 2024.

Hats must comply with the current Pony Club standards and be appropriately tagged.

No Jewellery to be worn. Long hair tied up and in a hairnet.

No horse or pony shall be left unattended or tied to a trailer or horse box unless supervised by a responsible person.
